"The gala is an opportunity for current CFC supporters from all over the world and new supporters from California and in particular the Bay Area, to come together and celebrate the successes of CFC as well as to raise awareness with new and potential supporters," said California Chapter Leader Edna Cooper of Piedmont

Caring for Cambodia is a non-profit organization that delivers free world-class education to over 6,600 students from preschool through high school in one of the poorest countries in the world. CFC also professionally trains and mentors teachers and has created and sustains 21 safe, modern, technologically equipped schools.

Jamie Amelio, founder and CEO of CFC, as well as a speaker and author, is the featured presenter for the Gala. Guests will enjoy a no host bar, exquisite passed hors d'oeuvres, seated dinner, dancing and a live auction. Live auction items will include a beautiful white scarf blessed by the Dalai Lama. Also on the auction block are vacation rentals in France, North Carolina, Santa Cruz and Lake Tahoe, a personalized bike tour through Napa with a special wine tasting, and a special dinner and tour around San Diego Bay aboard a 55-foot yacht.

The Gala will be held on Saturday, March 5, at 7 p.m. in the historic Julia Morgan Ballroom in the Merchants Exchange Building at 465 Californian Street in San Francisco. The Merchants Exchange building was one of the first steel framed high rise office buildings in San Francisco and a famous survivor of the 1906 earthquake.

Julia Morgan, California's most famous architect from the early 20th century, had her office in this same building for 50 years.

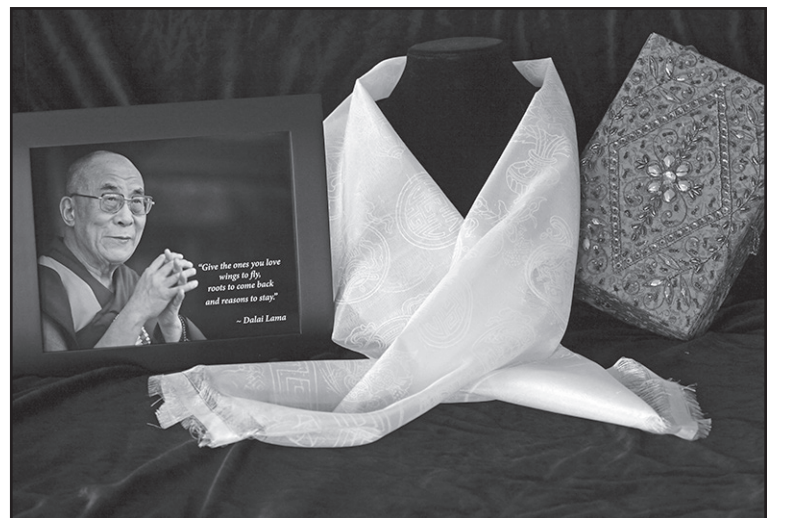
Last spring the club helped organize an event at the Piedmont Center for the Arts

were sent to Cambodia for families who could not afford these basic necessities.

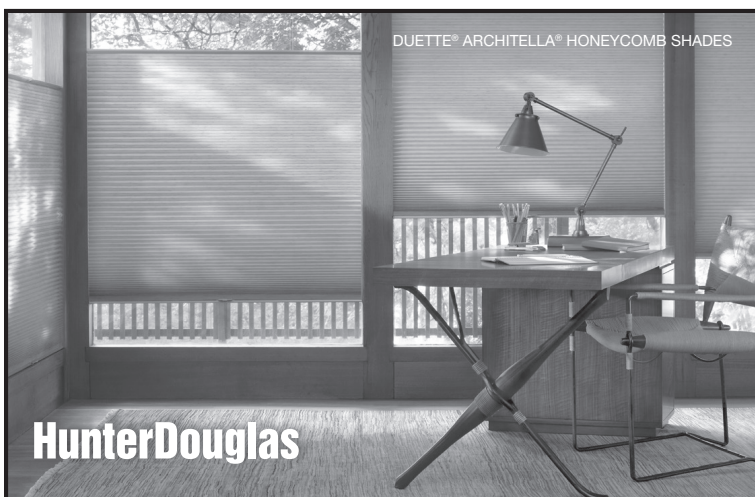
